

Council Chair Transition June 24, 2024

Overview

Leadership of the <u>Council on Linkages Between Academia and Public Health Practice</u> (Council) is provided by the Council Chair. C. William Keck, MD, MPH, Council representative for the <u>American Public Health Association</u>, has served as Chair since 1998 and is stepping down after 26 years of service. Elections for Council Chair are held every two years, and the 2024 election has recently concluded with the election of a new Chair.

Amy Lee, MD, MPH, MBA, <u>Association for Prevention Teaching and Research</u> representative to the Council and MPH Program Director, Consortium of Eastern Ohio Master of Public Health, <u>Northeast Ohio Medical University</u>, has been elected as incoming Council Chair. The Chair transition will take place over the coming months, and Dr. Keck will remain on the Council as APHA's representative. The Council thanks Dr. Keck for his years of dedicated service and welcomes Dr. Lee to her new position.
