

Strategies to Increase Bivalent Vaccinations

I. <u>Efficiency</u>

- a. Availability of vaccinators when there are interested residents/staff (regional health care coalitions, vaccinator teams at state agency
- b. MN Vaccine connector for direct scheduling at community vaccination sites
