

Core Competencies Workgroup Conference Call Meeting May 2, 2014

Purpose: This <u>Core Competencies Workgroup</u> meeting was held to discuss a preliminary draft of revisions to Tier 2 of the <u>Core Competencies for Public Health Professionals</u> (Core Competencies), developed based on <u>feedback gathered from the public health community</u>.

Discussion: During the meeting, the Core Competencies Workgroup:

Action: During the meeting, the Core Competencies Workgroup:

- Expressed agreement with the approach to drafting revisions and the efforts to simplify language.
- Suggested changes to the wording and order of competencies within the Analytical/Assessment Skills Domain.
- Emphasized the importance of including examples within competencies and providing versions of the Core Competencies both with and without "e.g.s."

Follow-Up: Following the meeting:

- Additional feedback on the preliminary draft of revisions to Tier 2 can be sent to Kathleen Amos at kamos@phf.org through May 14, 2014.
- The preliminary draft of revisions to Tier 2 was moved to the PHF Pulse blog to facilitate discussion. Feedback may be shared there as well.
- The draft of revisions to Tier 2 will be refined, and revisions to Tiers 1 and 3 will be drafted to align with the changes in Tier 2.
- Drafts, requests for input, and updates on the revision process will be sent to the Workgroup by email.
- Final draft revisions to the Core Competencies will be presented to the Council on Linkages Between Academia and Public Health Practice for approval in June 2014.
- Once the revisions are finished, the Core Competencies Workgroup will focus on resources to help the public health community transition to the revised Core Competencies.
