

## CDC E-Learning Institute Fellowship Program September 29, 2022

## Overview

The <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> (CDC) offers the <u>CDC E-Learning Institute</u> (ELI) to support public health professionals in cultivating skills for developing quality e-learning products. This free, six-month online fellowship offers access to CDC-developed materials and skilled training developers who serve as mentors, as well as peer learning opportunities. CDC is currently accepting applications for the ELI class of 2023, which will run from January-June 2023. Applications are due October 21, 2022.
