More than *just* a learning management system (LMS)

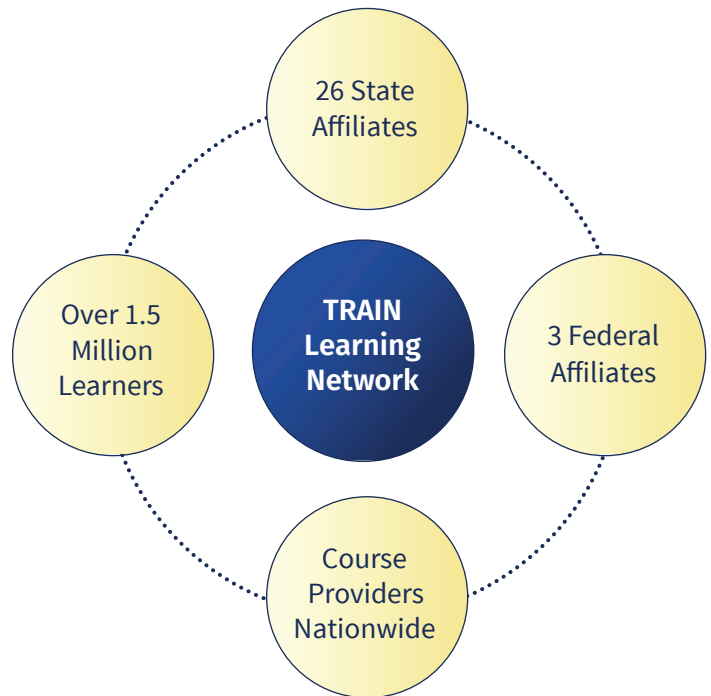


The TRAIN Learning Network is a centralized training platform designed to meet the evolving needs of health workers who protect and improve the public's health.

Beyond traditional LMS capabilities, TRAIN offers a community of national, state, and local affiliate agencies—known as the TRAIN Affiliate Consortium—that collaborates with our network of course providers and learners nationwide to ensure a well-prepared health workforce.

Affiliates can connect with fellow national, state, and local partners to:

- » **Share quality training** content, resources, and best practices through our annual meeting, bimonthly calls, and an active listserv
- » **Learn** about and access new training opportunities from other partners—a majority of which are free to learners, and many align with national standards
- » **Access content** from partners to develop targeted training plans

- » Avoid duplication of training efforts and **save** on cost and resources
